Thank you for considering contributing to the *California HomeSchooler* bi-monthly magazine.

The *California HomeSchooler* accepts submissions concerning homeschooling, life learning, progressive education, programs for kids, parent support, and auto-didactic learning. Submissions from HSC members have priority. Submissions from homeschoolers in California who are not HSC members have second priority. All other homeschoolers outside of California and non-homeschoolers in California will be considered, but we offer no guarantee of usage. Additionally, submissions from groups outside of HSC may be included in up to two issues per calendar year.

Submissions can be of any length. Generally, articles are between 500 and 1500 words. Contributors are not paid, but all published contributors will receive a free copy of the issue in which their article is printed.

Submissions are welcomed from amateur as well as professional writers. The editor will work with any contributors on presentation and formatting, if necessary. The *California HomeSchooler* is written by homeschoolers, for homeschoolers, so the tone is friendly and from the heart. We like to include articles that make our readers feel positive towards their decision to homeschool and inspire them to learn new things. Please, no advertisements disguised as articles. If you have a product or website, you may mention it in your bio.
